



Michigan Warriors Jam Fest **Tournament Rules**

1. Michigan High School Rules will apply to all games played in this tournament.
2. The Michigan Warrior Jam Fest will observe AAU guidelines for age and grade level from 2014.
3. Game time is forfeit time depending on situation. Director makes final call
4. 3 Minute Warm-up, 3 minute halftime
5. 5 fouls to foul out
6. Two Techs and you are out of the game plus sit the next game including coaches. 2 automatic points and the ball out for a tech.
7. 15U, 16U and 17U will play two 16 minute halves with stopped-clock unless there is a 20 point lead or more then the clock will convert to running time.
8. 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 13U and 14U will play two 14 minute halves with stopped-clock unless there is a 20 point lead or more then the clock will convert to running time.
9. If team is up 20 points with 2 minutes to go in the game, the game will be over.
10. 1st overtime is two minutes. 2nd overtime is first team to score wins.
11. Three timeouts per game(2 full & 1 thirty). They can carry over to the second half. No regular timeouts carry over to overtime. 1 extra timeout for first overtime. No timeouts for 2nd overtime.
12. Please have your books with player info just in case we have a dispute with the age and grade of a player.
13. You can protest a player's eligibility at \$100 FEE. If guilty you will get your money back
14. Please supply one parent each game 18 and up to either run the clock or do scorekeeping.
15. Please let your fans know that this is a friendly environment. Any fighting, bad language or bad mouthing the refs is subject to removal from tournament and property.
16. Tie-breakers are determined by first head to head competition and then by a point system. +15 points is the most you can receive for a win and -15 is the most you will receive for losing. Lastly, by least amount of points given up
17. Unsigned seniors can play with no more than 3 players per team.
18. Trophies and medals go to first and second place teams.
19. Up to two coaches (must be in coache's gear) will be allowed in free and one score keeper. You must wear your wristband all weekend or you have to pay.
20. Admission is \$5 on Friday and \$10 all day Saturday and \$10 all day Sunday for ages 13 and up. Kids 12 and under are free.
21. Age/Grade divisions with 24 teams will have a Gold, Silver and Bronze bracket playoff with the 1st place team playing in Gold, 2nd place team playing in Silver and 3rd place team playing in Bronze. Any age/grade divisions with less than 24 teams will have one playoff bracket with top 2 teams from each pool advancing to playoff bracket.
22. Players from the same organization can play up if that team chooses to move him up. (Example: If 6th grader from same organization gets done with his 6th

grade team and 7th grade team from same organization wants him to play with them, then he can. That player has to be there at the start of the game. A player can only play down if he's not that good and it is approved by tournament director before tourney.
